

DISINFECTING & SCALE REMOVAL FOR THE VICKS STARRYNIGHT HUMIDIFIER



You should clean your Vicks StarryNight Cool Moisture Humidifier weekly while in use.

Cleaning involves two steps – scale removal followed by and disinfecting. It is important that when cleaning the Vicks StarryNight Humidifier, these steps are performed in order, to avoid harmful chemical interactions.

Prior to cleaning commencement filter needs to be removed. Failure to remove the filter during cleaning will destroy the filter.

Vicks recommends only using [Protec WF2 Replacement Wicking Filters](#). The use of other filters may lead to substandard performance.

Replacing the filter

1. Turn off and unplug your humidifier.
2. Remove the water tank (refer diagrams in Vicks StarryNight Humidifier instruction booklet for guidance).
3. Remove filter tray from unit. Discard old filter and set filter tray aside.
4. Soak new filter in cool water. DO NOT WRING FILTER.
5. Insert new filter into filter tray. Place filter tray back in humidifier.

NOTE: for best fit and performance remove filter tray from the humidifier and insert pre-soaked new filter.

6. Replace the water tank.

Scale removal

1. Turn off and unplug your humidifier.
2. Remove and empty the water tank.
3. Remove the filter and set aside.
4. Remove filter tray and fill filter tray and water tank with undiluted white vinegar, and soak for 10-15 minutes.
5. Using undiluted vinegar, wipe base thoroughly.
6. Rinse water tank, filter tray and base thoroughly with water to remove scale.

Disinfecting

1. Turn off and unplug your humidifier.
2. Remove and empty the water tank.
3. Remove the filter and set aside.
4. Dilute 1 tablespoon of bleach in about 3.7 litres of cool water (the amount that fills the entire humidifier).
5. Fill water tank with the water and bleach solution. Remove water tray from unit and fill with the remaining water and bleach solution. Wipe base with the same solution.
6. Let stand for 20 minutes.
7. Rinse water tray and tank thoroughly until the smell of bleach is gone.
